Those of you who missed Bev Willaims speak to us at the last meeting missed a treat. She started with some family history that connected her whakapapa to Taranaki and Wales. Bev's weaving journey only started 15 years ago when she turned 70. At this age she decided that harakeke would be too hard on her hands so uses wool. One of the first korowai she made was for her family and this has been used by several members already. She has used feathers from a number of different native and non-native birds and explained how they are inserted to prevent them falling out. The korowai were stunning and considering each one takes 1-2 years to make, Bev has been incredibly productive and innovative in her designs.

A big announcement at the meeting was the launch of our new website. Subsequently an email has been sent to all members. You can now view our website from a variety of devices and you can book classes and retreats online. Payments are still to be done through direct banking to avoid the surcharges that would have occurred through the website. From a Committee perspective, it is now much easier to keep the website up to date. Helper Duties

If you are new to helping out with duties, the following is a simple version of what is expected.

Hall	Please arrive by 12.45 to help put out chairs in the hall and at the end of meeting help stack any unreturned chairs to back of hall.


