Block of the Month

Jagged X's









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Materials

Solid You are given a dark green or a white fabric Bright coloured You will need to provide 8 different scraps of bright any coloured fabric. They need to be 2 % x 3 % inch strips.



Cut the solid into 8 strips 2 % x 3 % inch strips Cut each of the coloured scraps into 2 % x 3 % inch strips

Method

- 1. Lay a coloured rectangle on to a background rectangle as shown. Draw a line as shown on to the coloured fabric corner to corner.
- 2. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim excess corner fabric leaving ¼ " seam.
- 3. Press seam open. Your rectangle should measure 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 4. Repeat 7 times making 8 blocks altogether
- 5. Select two pieced rectangles with different prints and stitch together as shown. Press seams open.

 Repeat to make 4 squares. Each will now measure 4 ½" square
- 6. Take two blocks, turn on sideways and sew together as per sample block. Repeat with the other two blocks then sew these together.
- 7. Your block should measure 8 ½ " square including seam allowance
