September: Joanne Knight – Identity Theft

As well as being a Lion by weekend and evening, by day Joanne is an Identification Consultant at the Department of Internal Affairs, Te Tari Taiwhenua (New Zealand).

She developed the New Zealand's Identification Standards, and is responsible for their promotion and ongoing maintenance. She provides advisory services to government which includes education, assessing identification risk and advice on the design of identification processes. Joanne is also editor of ISO/IEC 29003 – Identity Proofing an international standard.

The primary driver for what she does, is the prevention of Identity Theft. This takes a two pronged approach. One side is getting organisations to adopt better practices through use of standards, the other is helping individuals to better protect themselves through education.

Helper Duties

Hall	Please arrive by 12.45 to help put out chairs in the hall and at the end of meeting help
	stack any unreturned chairs to back of hall.
