

COASTAL QUILTERS

February 2026 BOM

Material


In your pack you have been given:

- Two Dark green 2.5" strips approximately 18" long
- One Cream 2.5" strip approx. 18" long

You need to provide one 2.5" strip approx. 18" long. It must have some green in it.

Method

1. Sew the four strips together using accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams ensuring the two dark strips are on the outsides.



2. Press seams in one direction. The strip set should measure 8.5" in width. From this strip set, cut two 8.5" squares.

3. Turn one square 90 degrees and place right sides together with the other square. Pin or clip together.

4. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam all around the outside of the square.



5. Without moving your fabric, carefully cut on the two diagonals.



6. Open out the four squares and press. As you do this, number each square clockwise from the top right as in photo G below on the left.

7. Working carefully, follow the instructions for each numbered square so that they end up positioned as in photo H on the right.

#1 – turn 90 ° to the right.

#2 – turn 90 ° to the right.

#3 – put in the place of number 4 as is. Don't rotate.

#4 – put in the place of number 3 and turn 180 °.



8. Sew squares together. Be careful not to stretch the fabric as you sew. The squares have bias edges and are more likely to stretch out of shape. If you have spray starch, a suggestion would be to spray and iron at step 2.
